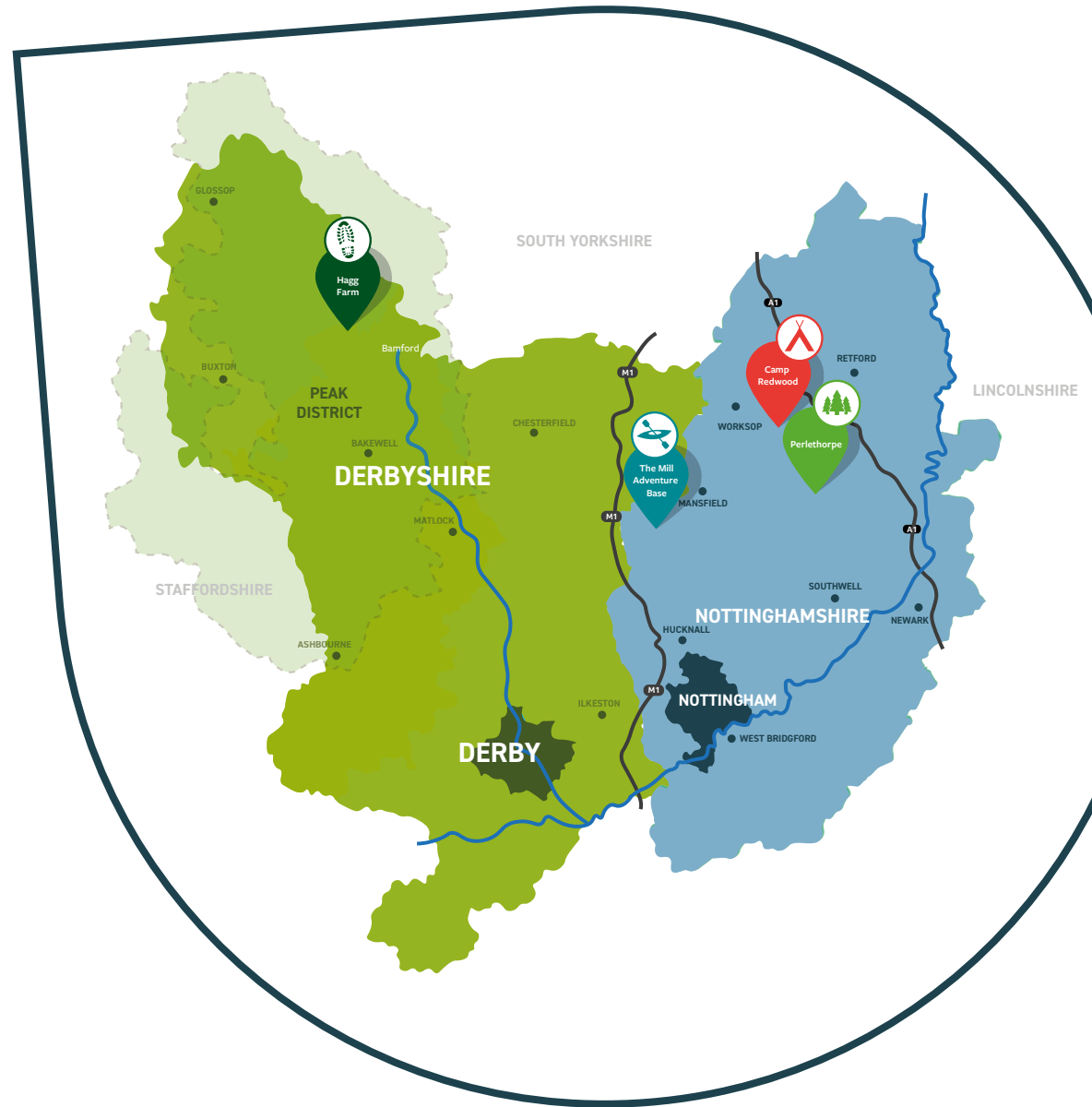
Welcome to Notts Outdoors

Hagg Farm

- Sleeps up to 62 across two accommodation units in a mixture of two, four, six and eight bed dormitories
- Large dining room
- Games room
- Reception area

In the heart of the Peak District, between the spectacular Derwent Valley and Kinder Scout, you'll find high quality outdoor education and residential visits for schools and groups at Hagg Farm.

Experience instructor-led activities both onsite and offsite, such as rock climbing, canoeing, abseiling, caving, mine exploration, stream scrambling, mountain walking, indoor climbing, high-ropes activities and field studies. Students and staff are provided with walking boots, waterproofs and rucksacks as necessary.

There is plenty of outside space across the centre, including a large back field for games and the wildlife garden. We also offer great catering to keep the students – and staff! - going through busy days of activities.

This purpose built urban adventure centre provides exciting, adventurous activities alongside an overnight stay in our cleverly-designed pods.

Our pods give you all the excitement of camping in a safe, comfortable and secure area, making them perfect for an overnight stay. They are insulated and carpeted for warmth and comfort, and are equipped with an electrical socket and lighting. Heaters can be provided if required.

We have a variety of self-led activities to keep your class entertained in the evening, and welcome you to bring any of your own too.

Our Pod Residentials are fully inclusive and include transport (subject to availability) and catering.

Adventurous activities

If it's thrilling outdoor activities you're looking for, The Mill Adventure Base is for you.

Pupils can experience a range of adventurous activities, indoor and outdoor, on land and on water. Packages can be built to suit the needs of your group, with options from two hour sessions to half days, full days or a seasonal block of adventures.

Some of the activities on offer include:

Climbing tower

Our 12 metre climbing tower will test your skills. From easy beginner climbs to harder overhangs, this activity has something to challenge everybody.

Zip wire

Starting from the top of our 12-metre climbing tower, our twin 100 metre zip wires fly over the site and give great views of the reservoir and beyond.

Raft building

Teams have two hours to build a raft from barrels, poles and ropes. The team then have to test it out and hopefully stay dry!

Abseiling

Come and try abseiling from our new activity tower.

We have an 8 metre and a 10 metre abseil available as well as a free hanging one.

This is a great individual activity to teach confidence and resilience.



Canoeing/Katacanoe

Navigate your boat with your team across Kingsmill Reservoir, learning a new skill and working as a team.

GCSE P.E.

We deliver GCSE related activities including grading and assessment opportunities in the following:

- Climbing
- Paddle sports
- Orienteering
