- Suitable for KS 2-5
- Can sleep up to 62
- Exclusive use of site when booked

From rock climbing and abseiling, to caving, mine exploration and stream scrambling, and more - a fantastic range of activities await at Hagg Farm. Some experiences take place off site providing the opportunity to explore the local area. All activities whether on site or off site are led by our instructors. Walking boots, waterproofs and rucksacks are provided.

The centre is made up of two accommodation units across a central courtyard. The main centre has forty-four beds, and the John Hunt Base has eighteen beds. They can be booked separately or together, and schools have sole use of the accommodation that they book. Both include large dining/group rooms, well-appointed bathrooms for pupils and staff alongside use of a drying room. The main centre also has a games room and comfortable reception area. Overnight accommodation is in a mixture of two, four, six and eight-bed dormitories. There is plenty of outside space including a large back field for games and the wildlife garden. Hagg Farm prides itself on great catering to keep the students going through busy days of activities.

St Michael's Environmental Education Centre

- Suitable for KS 1 & 2
- Can sleep up to 34
- Exclusive use of site when booked

St Michael's is located in the heart of the Peak District National Park, and has been welcoming school groups for over 30 years. In 2019 the centre became the first Peak District National Park Ambassador Centre.

School groups benefit from exclusive use of the centre and are supported by a small team of dedicated staff.

There are a number of walks your group can take to discover the rich history and geography of the area, whilst being immersed in the local beauty. Discover Stanage Edge, Padley Gorge and Eyam Village to name a few.

The centre has a large comfortable lounge, dining and kitchen area. There is a large TV, library, WiFi and plenty of games. There are 34 pupil and 4 staff beds in the centre and up to 4 additional staff can be accommodated in the adjoining cottage.

The dormitories are cosy and the showers are hot. Catering packages are available or schools can self cater. Children are provided with waterproofs,

Camp Redwood is situated in Sherwood Forest which was once the home of the infamous Robin Hood and his Merry Men.



This unique venue provides pupils with the opportunity to get back to basics with outdoor experiences designed to help them develop and grow. Activities will focus on resilience, confidence, problem-solving, teamwork and fun!

Our programme of activities is built around what is available in the natural environment, such as shelter building, bushcraft activities, and roasting marshmallows around a campfire which students will light themselves! Overnight, pupils will camp in spacious bell tents Camp Redwood is the perfect environment for larger groups.

Perlethorpe Bunkhouse

- Suitable for KS 1 & 2
- Can sleep up-to 6o
- Stay in the bunkhouse and barn

This one night residential is a self catering option. Schools will have full access to the kitchen during their visit, plus cooking options of a potato baker, pizza oven and gas BBQ. During their stay children will have the opportunity to shelter build, make campfires, go on a bat walk and take a 'dip' in the River Meden.

The bunkhouse can sleep up to 60 children. Pop up tents are available for teachers in the Stag Barn next to the bunkhouse.


